We know it has been a tremendously hard year for so many who have lost jobs, loved ones and the simple day-to-day social engagement that was life as we knew it. Through it all, we have been amazed by the resiliency of individuals and the non-profits we serve alongside.

The strength and support of our Thrive family has been tremendously generous and we want you to share in the celebration of everything we have accomplished in 2020. We were only able to achieve these things because of the way you wrapped your arms around our non-profit.

You're the reason we thrived! Thank you!!

Here are just a few of the highlights:

- Since 2017, TGP has been able to impact over 15,000 students!
- Piloted the new, Ready to Thrive Program that supports students going into college with small minischolarships
- Created and implemented the Thrive Virtual Summit with community experts
- Gave 71 scholarships to 43 students to help with basic needs while attending college during COVID
- Secured four NEW grants, including The United Way, Global Giving, Peninsula Community Club
- Created a socially distanced event to pack 600 backpacks for marginalized students
- National coverage by Spanx through the Global Giving Red Backpack Fund
- Gave mini-grants to 10 partners (local and global)
- Raised over \$19,000 with Wofford Greek Week ALL virtually
- Created impact for 6,508 students in 2020
- Pivoted all events to virtual quite the feat!
- Virtual Gala Event that raised over \$123,000!!

OUR CORE PROGRAMS

Unzip Your Potential Program

The flagship program that Thrive is founded on. Provides low-opportunity K-12 students with a resourced-filled backpack and expert-led workshops to empower students with equitable classroom experiences.

Ready To Thrive Program (RTT)

In 2020, we piloted the Ready to Thrive program as a response to COVID-19. Through this program, we provide low-income, high-achieving, at-risk college students with scholarships, access to technology, and expert-led programming designed to help these students to have a more equitable college experience.

Programming includes: Financial literacy, Mental health and well-being, technology best practices, and internship and career readiness.

"The Ready to Thrive workshops provided new ways for me to manage my stress so I can experience college in the best way possible without letting it take a toll on my mental health.

Also, having that \$500 made me feel immensely secure and confident that I wouldn't have to worry about financials in regards to basic needs I may have while away from home."

STORY OF IMPACT

JAELA'S STORY

As a first-generation college student, I can personally say that the Thrive Global Project has provided me with not only financial support but also mental support. Before entering college, I was in a consistent battle with my mental health. There was never a time when I wasn't anxious or I didn't overthink. While some of my worries came from my personal life, most of them were about college. I didn't know how I was going to receive enough money to attend school and provide for myself.

I also feared being away from home and being unable to connect and relate to new people. While therapy was an option, I didn't have any motivation to go. I also didn't think I was going to be consistent nor be able to verbally express how I felt. It wasn't until after attending my first Thrive Virtual Summit in July of 2020 that I realized, people are around to help me.



During the Thrive Virtual Summit, I attended three workshops. The first one focused on stress reduction. Throughout the workshop, I learned new ways to make my well-being a priority. I also learned about self-awareness, self-care, and how to eliminate stress, which was something I needed at the time. The second workshop focused on financial literacy. During this workshop, I discovered new ways to budget and handle my money responsibly. The final workshop was centered around succeeding as a freshman in college.



In December, I attended the second Thrive Virtual Summit, During each workshop, I felt comfortable talking about my problems, discovered more about myself, and ultimately gained new information and tips about opportunities that would help me succeed as a first-generation college student. Ultimately, I am extremely grateful for all that the Thrive Global Project has done for me.

Not only have they allowed me to connect with others, but also they have also ensured me that I have support and guidance, regardless of anything.



2020 READY TO THRIVE PROGRAM RESULTS:

Provided 72 students with expert-led workshops to increase student college readiness in the following areas:

- 1) Financial Literacy
- 2) Stress Management, Mindfulness & Wellness
- 3) Career/Internship Readiness

We also provided 72 students with scholarships to increase broader economic mobility, social capital, and racial equity to reduce financial stress and hardship on families so students can focus on education.

This model allows us to partner with a large number of programs on the ground both in the US and overseas and connect with students and families in unique and powerful ways.

In February of 2020, we partnered with Love One International to empower 600 students in Uganda by providing them with a backpack filled with resources and supplies to help them be successful in the classroom.

Through this campaign, we raised \$10,000!
